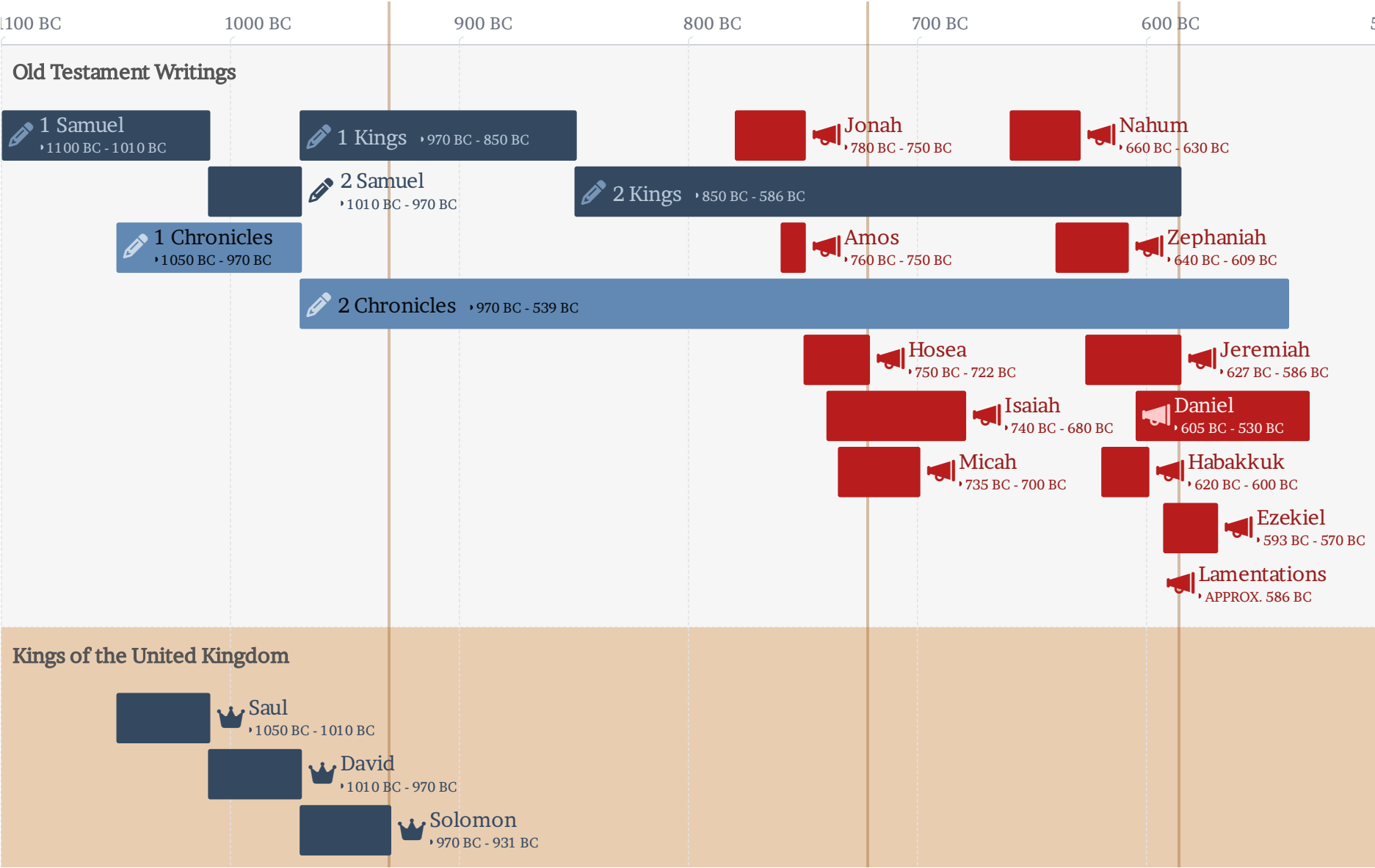
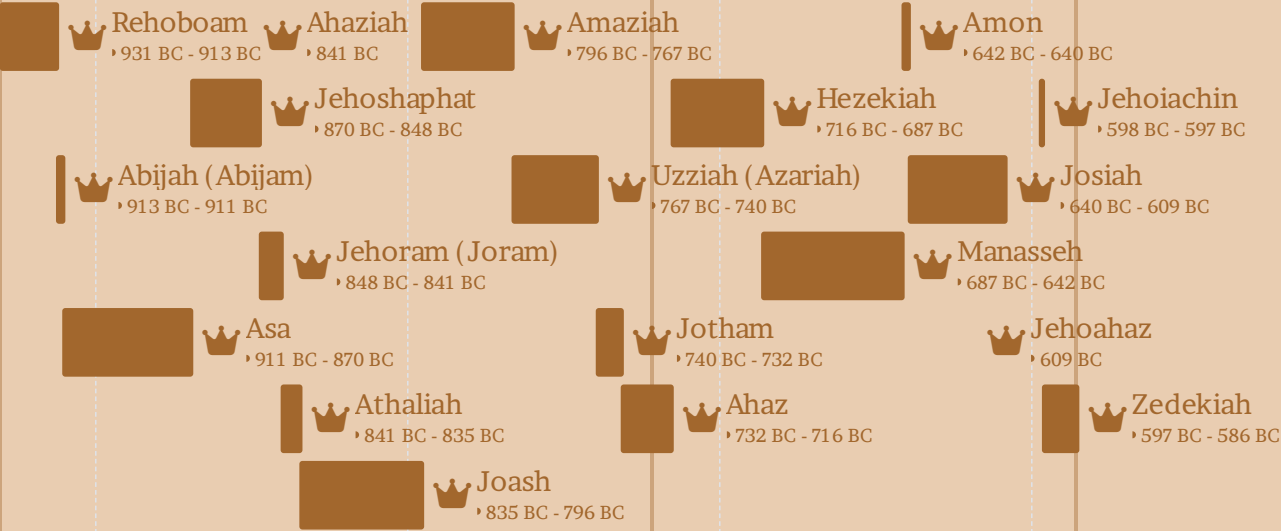


Old Testament: The Kingdoms of Israel and Judah

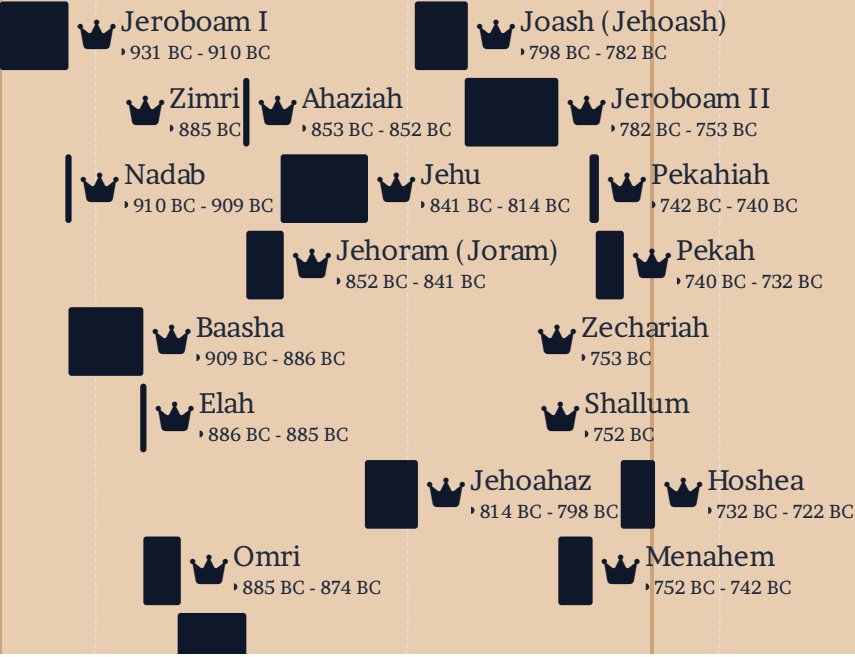

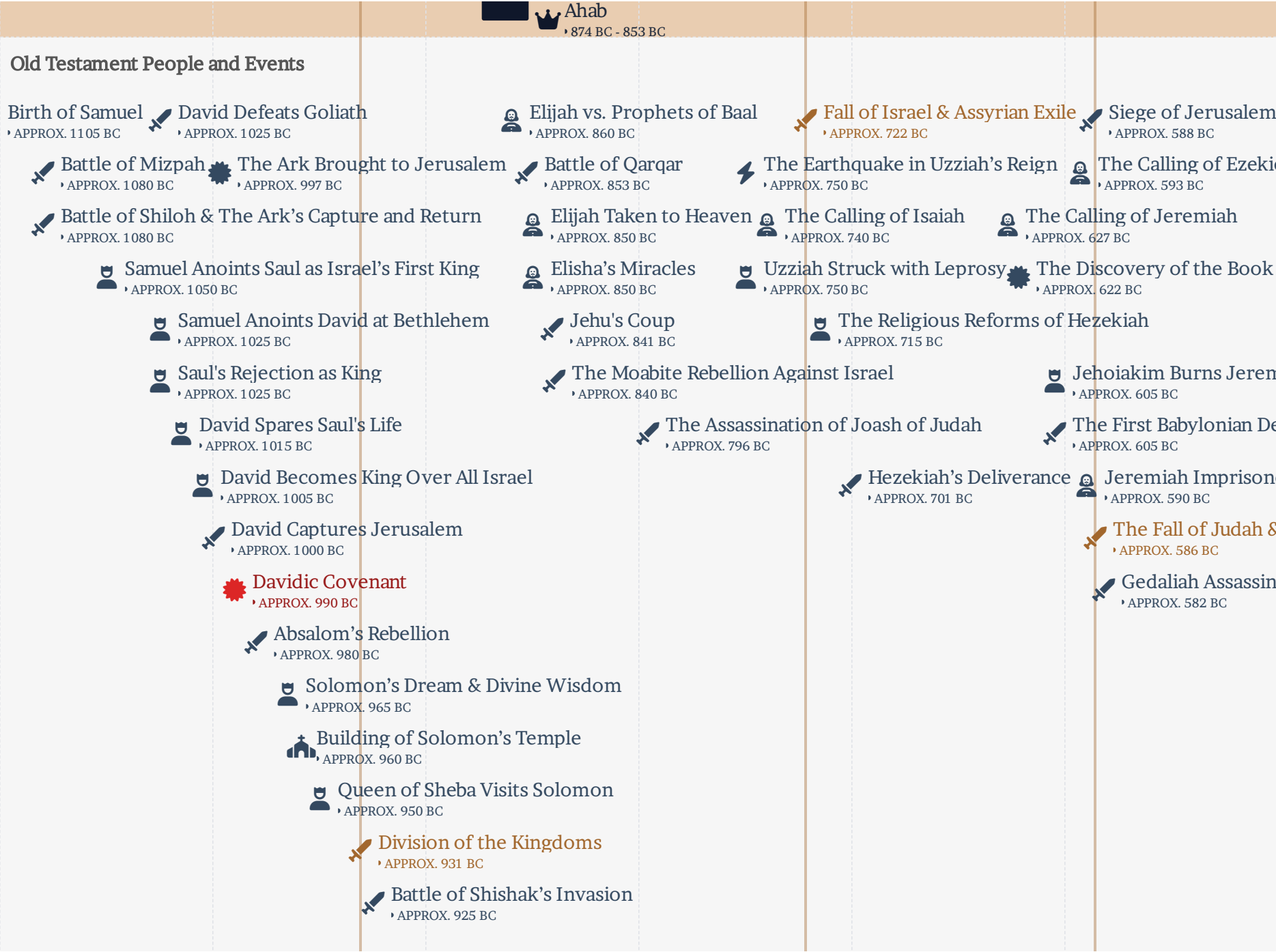
